

## **BIBLICAL NUMBERS**

- 1 God - The number for God, God the Father, God the Son, Jesus, and God the Holy Spirit are all of one. Not 3 Gods, but 1 God in 3 unique forms.**
- 2 Testimony/Unity - Everything is confirmed by the witness of two or more. 10 commandments are in two tablets. God accepts the second but rejects the first. Two testaments in the Bible. Night and Day, Good and Evil. Man and Woman are joined in marital unity but both give vows or their testimony as a commitment to one another first.**
- 3 Completeness - God is 3 in 1. It took 3 days and 3 nights to complete salvation. 3 fathers (Abraham, Isaac, Jacob) 3 parts to old testament (Law, Prophets, Writings), 3 parts to new testament (Gospels, Letters, Prophecy). Takes the (1) God and the Unity of God (2) and forms completeness (3).**
- 4 Messiah - All forms of 4 are related to the Messiah including the Fourth Hebrew word in the Bible which is Alef and Tav or the first letters of the Hebrew Alphabet. 4 seasons, 4 gospels and 4 major prophets. Jesus is from the fourth son of Jacob, Judah. Takes the one God (1) and the Completeness of God (3) and makes the messiah who was united in God.**
- 5 Grace/Faith/Mercy- Every language in the word has grace with 5 letters, 5 virgins get into heaven because of their Faith (Matthew 25). Pentecost (50<sup>th</sup>) was the day the law was given in faith and the day the Holy Spirit descended upon man for good.**

**The Unity of God with the testimony of God creates faith in God and mercy from God and grace from God.**

- 6 Man – Six is 1 short of seven (which is perfection). 666 is the number of the antichrist which is complete imperfection. 6<sup>th</sup> months of Hebrew calendar is the month for repentance of man. Man was created on the sixth day of creation.**
- 7 Perfection – God created the world in 7 days, In the 7<sup>th</sup> month of Hebrew calendar is the day of atonement (day of judgement) and feast of tabernacles in which when God dwells with us. Seven Feasts of the lord (Leviticus 23). Seven days to create the world. This is why we rest on the seventh day. God’s perfect plan. 777 is perfection in unity. Also seven is the Messiah and Unity in God and Jesus unifies us with God which was his perfect plan.**
- 8 New Beginnings - 8<sup>th</sup> day of feast of tabernacles represents Heaven/Eternal life. Anytime you see 8, you know that it is involving something recreated or something new. The 8<sup>th</sup> book of the Bible tells the story of a widow who gains a new life by marrying a kinsman redeemer. Ruth then went on to be a matriarch in the line of Jesus, who is our Kinsman redeemer.**
- 9 Finality/Judgement – God’s completeness (3) and man’s sinfulness (6) bring on the judgement of God. Also used for finality or to bring an end. Christ died in the 9<sup>th</sup> hour. The destruction of both Jerusalem temples occurred on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of the month of Av.**
- 10 Divine Order – 10 plagues on Egypt, 10 Commandments, Noah was the 10<sup>th</sup> generation from Adam. 10 Clauses in the Lord’s**

**prayer. Formed with the completeness of God (3) and the perfection of God (7). Also associated with man in relation to messiah, (6) man and (4) messiah. 10 Virgins (Matthew 25). 10 lepers cleansed.**

**11 Disorder – irresponsibility of humans. John saw 11 things in connection with the final judgement in revelation (20:12-14). King Jehoiakim reigned 11 years before Babylon took the nation of Judah into exile. The 11<sup>th</sup> month of the year is the month of repentance of man. With Judas's betrayal and death, it brought disorder to the disciples clan.**

**12 – God's Government - 12 Tribes of Isreal, 12 Disciples. 12 spies sent into the land of Canaan. There are 12 hours in the day and 12 in the night. There are 12 months in the year to govern the year. 12 people on a jury and 12 eggs in a carton (ok, may be unrelated). But there will be 12 types of fruit on the tree of life. (Revelation 22:2)**
